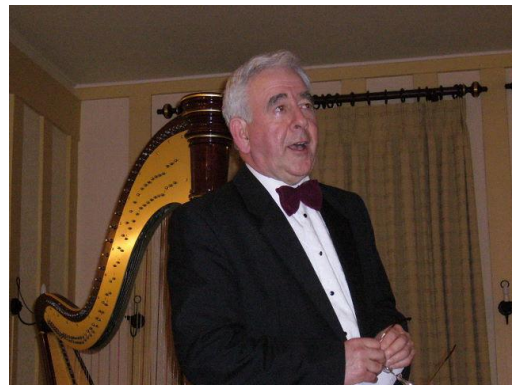
Our thanks to Ralph for organising the event and to the ladies of the committee for arranging the flowers and deciding on the menu.
